## 2019 Summer Academic Scholarships

## Dear Parents:

The teachers and support staff in your school district, through the Lowell Education Association (LEA), are offering their students *Summer Academic Scholarships*. Scholarships are to be used for academically enriching programs. The scholarships are to help cover the cost of an academic program and are given in amounts not to exceed 50% or \$100 of the total cost of the program. Amounts awarded are dependent on the number of applicants.
